Dear Parents and Carers

Did you know ... just registering your child for Free School Meals means that the school gets extra money?

Also..... If we know you are a Services family we can get extra funding for the school.

Register now to make sure you don't miss out

The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income and service families do their very best. This funding is called a 'Pupil Premium'.

For every child registered The Corbet School gets £488 this year.

With this money we could provide additional resources and educational visits which would benefit pupils in the school and enhance their learning experience.

Please register before Christmas to make sure your child and others in their class don't miss out.

How does it work?

1. First, check if you qualify – it is not just if you are unemployed, so please look at the list on the next page.
2. Registering is really quick and easy – if you think you qualify, contact the school office for a form or e-mail fsm@shropshire.gov.uk; their advisors will help you to register.
3. If you want your child to have a free, healthy meal at lunchtime that's great – they will get the free meal (saving you more than £350 a year), extra benefits and the school gets £488 extra.
4. If you don't want your child to have the school meals they can continue as normal – as long as you qualify and are registered, the school still gets £488 extra.

No one will know you have registered and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming. Also, Free School Meal tickets are identical in appearance to pre-paid tickets.

Do you qualify?

You can register your child for Free School Meals if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' - the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Pupils can also register for Free School Meals if they get any of these benefits themselves.

Come and talk to us if you're not sure.

If you are a service family and have a child enrolled at The Corbet School please contact us to register them. This would enable us to take advantage of the additional funding for the benefit of your school.
