Safer School Initiative

The Safer School initiative is a school security and personal safety programme that drives a practical and realistic approach to managing safety in school

A Safer School Group meets on a 6 monthly basis and is represented by school staff, pupils, local police, community members, and the county Crime Prevention Officer.

Incidents that occur at school are recorded in respect of the type of incident, the location, and the action taken. The incident record logs are reviewed at the meetings and help formulate future policies and procedures.

Our main security initiatives continue to be the use of our CCTV and Identity Badge system which must be worn by all staff and visitors. Pupils are encouraged to report any occasion where they see a person not wearing a badge, whereupon staff will take immediate action.

Our Safer School Policy Statement is as follows:-

'The school has recognised the link between a successful school, pupil contentment, parent satisfaction, community involvement and the implementation of an effective risk management system.

Through the risk management system the school intends to establish the safety and security of pupils, staff, and their property. This will be achieved by monitoring activity and maintaining the vigilance of staff and pupils in order to reduce levels of anti social behaviour and criminal activity.
